

PRESENTATIONS TASKSHEET 4

Situation:

Mr Faulkner has asked you to prepare a presentation that is to be given as part of Environment Week. The theme of the presentation is 'Clean Energy'. He wants you to prepare an interesting show about generating electricity by natural means.

Task:

Build a PowerPoint presentation based on this situation. This is an individual project. Your energy methods must include: wind and solar...

..and one other of your choice. Can you find something about electricity generated by waves for example? Or what about hydro-electricity?

On paper, build up an idea of what could be included in the presentation before you begin work at the computer.

Assessment:

I will be marking this on the basis of:

- The use of text and graphics in 'sensible' balance
- How well you get the message about clean electricity across
- How well you make the elements fit your presentation and its aims
- Do the elements on a slide 'flow' in an eye catching or pleasing way
- How informative the notes accompanying the slides are.

Requirements:

- Prepare a master slide which gives a common theme to all the slides in the presentation. Use background colour, a logo/picture, title, paragraph and bullet point styles. Slide numbers must be shown.
- Must have a 'Title' slide which will be displayed until the presentation starts. This must contain your Name and tutor group, a background picture and the title "Environmentally friendly electricity " in bright blue on a pale blue background.
- NO SOUND EFFECTS AT ALL
- There must be at least 3 further slides which give information about the 3 methods of electricity generation
- There must be notes which accompany these 3 slides which outline the method, where in the world this is, or could be, used effectively
- This presentation must be saved in your 'Home' folder with the name: "*Electricity*".
