

Website Authoring assignment – Colin’s Coin Shop

You have been asked by the owners of Colin’s Coin and Banknote Shop, a successful and well respected business in the world of numismatics. They buy and sell coins and banknotes. The description is below. The company has a strict style policy that applies to all publicity material and must be closely followed.

1. These styles must be applied, either as a separate style sheet linked to the web page or within the <style> tags in the <head> section of the web page.

Paragraph text: font face Verdana, size 14, yellow (#ffcc00), justified
Bullet lists: font face Verdana, size 12, yellow (#ffcc00), left aligned
Heading 1: font face Lucida Calligraphy, size 24, gold (#ffff00), bold, centered
Heading 2: font face, Lucida Calligraphy, size 18, gold (#ffff00), bold, italic, left
Table and cells: border 2px, border colour (#800000), collapsed
The background of the page is to be a rust type colour (#cc3300)

2. Change the contents of the <title> tag to be: **Colin’s Coin & Banknote Shop**
Add the author <meta> tag to contain your name.

3. The page is to have a layout like this:

4. In the heading row enter as style Heading 1: **Welcome to Colin’s Coin & Banknote Shop**

5. In the menu column enter in style Heading 2:

6. In Cell A as style paragraph:
Colin’s Coin Shop is one of the north of England’s most trusted and respected dealers of rare coins and English paper money. Established in 1960, it has grown into a dealership with an unequalled catalogue of hammered and milled coins, and more recently a growing reputation for the acquisition of paper money, most notably Treasury notes. The two areas below will link you to these areas of the dealership, where held and auction items can be viewed.

7. In Cell B as style Heading 2: **Banknotes**, centered in the cell
In Cell C as style Heading 2: **Coins**, centered in the cell
In Cell D you need the photograph PeppiattRed.jpg, resized to have a width of 300 pixels
In Cell E you need the photograph Charles1Shilling.jpg, resized to a width of 150 pixels

When resizing these images that the aspect ratio is maintained.

- 8** In Cell F add the bullet points:
- Treasury Notes 1914-1928
 - Patrick Mahon 1925-1929
 - Basil Catterns 1929-1934
 - Kenneth Peppiatt 1934-1949
 - Percival Beale 1949-1962

- 9.** In Cell G add the bullet points:
- Hammered coins 1066-1662
 - Milled coins 1658-date
- 10.** Add a hyperlink to the menu item **Ye Olde Banknote Shoppe** to open the website www.oldbanknoteshop.co.uk in a new window.
- 11.** Add a hyperlink to the picture of the **King Charles Shilling** to open the website www.ringramcoins.com in a new window.
- 12.** Print out a copy of the HTML code for this page and a copy of the page itself.
On the code printout highlight the:
- hyperlink tasks that you have introduced
 - Heading 1 and heading 2 tags
 - Bulleted list item tags
